



Exhibition Guidelines

Easts Photography Club (EPC) is a group of enthusiastic amateur photographers who enjoy sharing and learning from each other. We welcome all to our creative, friendly and inclusive group.

Each month, one of our meetings is devoted to an exhibition of photos from EPC members who can choose to submit photos which:

1. explore a **pre-defined topic** as outlined in the club calendar available from the website **or**
2. are in the **open category** i.e. on any subject matter the member chooses.

On most exhibition evenings a judge will be present to give feedback on how the photos have interpreted "the brief".

- Entries are only open to financial members of EPC.
- Exhibitions start at 7.30pm sharp via Zoom. Members will receive email with link.
- A maximum of 2 Images can be submitted each month.
- Images may be printed or digital.
- Images and post processing must be the member's own work.
- Images should have been taken or heavily processed less than 24 months previously.
- Maximum print size 40 x 50cm (16" x 20").
- Maximum digital image size is 1920 pixels on the longest side with a max. of 2 MB. Advice on resizing photos for submission is available from <https://www.groovypost.com/howto/use-windows-10-photos-app-to-resize-images/>
- Digital entries are to be sent by the Sunday night preceding the exhibition to:
 - esps.competition@gmail.com or
 - Down loaded into the appropriate folder on the club's Dropbox page.
- File names should follow this format: first name then topic then number e.g. Jane Reflection 01.
- All entries are subject to the approval of the Exhibition Secretary.
- Members agree to make their submitted images available for publishing on the Club's website.

Photographer led discussion

Photographers will have an opportunity to speak succinctly (under 2 minutes) about their images before judging. These discussion points may assist:

- Where was the photo taken?
- Why was this photo taken?
- Describe how the photo matches the brief.
- What camera and camera settings were used?
- What post processing techniques were used?
- What is the strength of the photo?
- What would you do differently?
- Any questions to the group?

Respectful feedback

After each member has presented their photos and the judge has commented; other members are encouraged to give respectful comments and suggestions or ask questions of the photographer.

Open photos and FCC

EPC is affiliated with the [Federation of Camera Clubs \(FCC\) NSW](#). As part of this membership EPC enters photos each year in the Interclub Competition usually held in October. This competition has 5 categories:

1. Australian Landscapes
2. Colour
3. Creative
4. Nature
5. Monochrome

Members may indicate that their photos might be considered as available for this competition. If this is the case, then the judge for the evening will apply a much stricter standard of feedback to those photos. More information on the categories and judging criteria is available from XXXXXXXX.

Member's project

Members are encouraged to work on a project each year. This project should be a challenge to do things photographically which extend each person's skills and vision. A maximum of 8 project photos for each member will be exhibited and discussed in the last meeting of November.

Photo of the Year

During the Christmas Party meeting of December each member is encouraged to exhibit one favourite print photo and one favourite digital photo which has previously being shown at an exhibition night during the current year. All club members will vote for their favourite.
